

Regulations for the Graduate Research Stipend of Program for Cultivating Global Leaders in Heavy Ion Radiotherapy, Science and Technology

July 2nd, 2020

Article 1. Purpose

These regulations prescribe matters necessary to the stipend for the academic research for students who are enrolled in Heavy Ion Medical and Engineering Course (hereafter, L-PhD Course) of the Program for Cultivating Global Leaders in Heavy Ion Radiotherapy, Science and Technology (hereafter, this program)

Article 2. Eligibility

- [1] Students who will be continuously enrolled in L-PhD Course for one year.
- [2] Students who do not obtain a research fellowship, receive other scholarships or earn constant income. (Excluding those who participate in TA/RA that are necessary for conducting the program and those who belong to Stipend Category C and D.)

Article 3. Application Procedures

After completing the university admission procedure, an individual who wishes to receive the L-PhD Graduate Research Stipend must submit application materials (Form1-1 ~ Form1-4) to the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering after a consultation with his/her academic adviser.

Article 4. Selection of Recipients

The recipients will be selected by the L-PhD Steering Committee and the L-PhD Meeting, with decisions finalized by the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering. The results will be announced to the recipients.

Article 5. Stipend Category

- [1] Category A··· ¥ 200,000/month
 - [2] Category B··· ¥ 150,000/month
 - [3] Category C··· ¥ 80,000/month
 - [4] Category D··· ¥ 50,000/month
- (2) Stipend category of each recipient is determined by the examination at the L-PhD Meeting, based on the recipient's academic research achievements in this program, financial status and future research prospects, while considering the budget constraints.

Article 6. Stipend Period

Stipend period is one fiscal year. The recipients are eligible for renewing and continuing to receive the stipend until the end of the standard course duration.

- (2) Even in the middle of the academic year, the recipients are allowed to start to receive the stipend in accordance with the semester.

Article 7. Stipend Payments

After confirming the recipient's enrollment at the end of every month, the payment will be made on 20th in the following month. However, if the payment date falls on Saturday or a public holiday, it will be made the day before Saturday or a public holiday. Also, if the payment date falls on Sunday, it will be made two days before Sunday.

- (2) The recipients do not have a repayment obligation.

Article 8. Suspension of the Stipend

If any of the events listed below applies to the recipient, the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering suspends the recipients' stipend and reports to the L-PhD Meeting.

- [1] Recipient's falsifying information on the application forms is revealed.
- [2] The recipient cannot continue to research due to illness.
- [3] The recipient takes a leave of absence, or withdraws from university.
- [4] The recipient obtains a research fellowship, receive other funding, or earn regular income.
- [5] Unsatisfactory academic performance or misconduct.

Article 9. Repayment of the Stipend

In cases where the L-PhD Meeting considers the recipient is disqualified to receive the stipend, the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering can reclaim the stipend that has been already paid during the specified period.

- (2) The recipient who is reclaimed the stipend must return it by the specified deadline.

Article 10. Transfer / Withdrawal

If any of the events listed below applies to the recipient, he/she must immediately submit "Notice Letter of Transfer/Withdrawal (Form 2)" to the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering.

- [1] When the information on the submitted application materials such as address or name has been changed.
- [2] When the recipient wishes to withdraw of the stipend.

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Article 11. Research Outcome Report

The recipients must submit “Research Outcome Report (Form 3)” at the end of the fiscal year to the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering by the specified deadline after a consultation with his/her academic adviser.

- (2) The Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering and L-PhD Committee members examine the submitted reports and evaluate the recipients’ performance.
- (3) Based on the evaluation, the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering will determine whether to continue to provide the recipient with the stipend and the recipient’s stipend category.

Article 12. Renewal Procedure

The recipient who wishes to continue to receive the stipend must submit the renewal application forms together with the research outcome report to the Dean of the Graduate School of Medicine/Science and Engineering after a consultation with his/her academic adviser.

Article 13. Competitive Research Fund

Regardless of the eligibility as noted “Article 2. Eligibility”, the recipients are allowed to apply for competitive research funds and receive funding in the cases where the funding is indispensable to conduct research activities.

Article 14. Administrative Work

Administrative work regarding L-PhD Graduate Research Stipend will be carried out by the department in charge.

Article 15. Miscellaneous Provisions

In addition to the prescriptions set forth in these regulations, matters necessary to L-PhD Graduate Research Stipend shall be separately stipulated.

Article 16. Alteration or Revocation

Alteration or revocation of these regulations shall be stipulated by the chairman of the L-PhD Steering Committee after a resolution of the L-PhD Steering Committee.

These regulations shall come into effect from March 16, 2012.
